

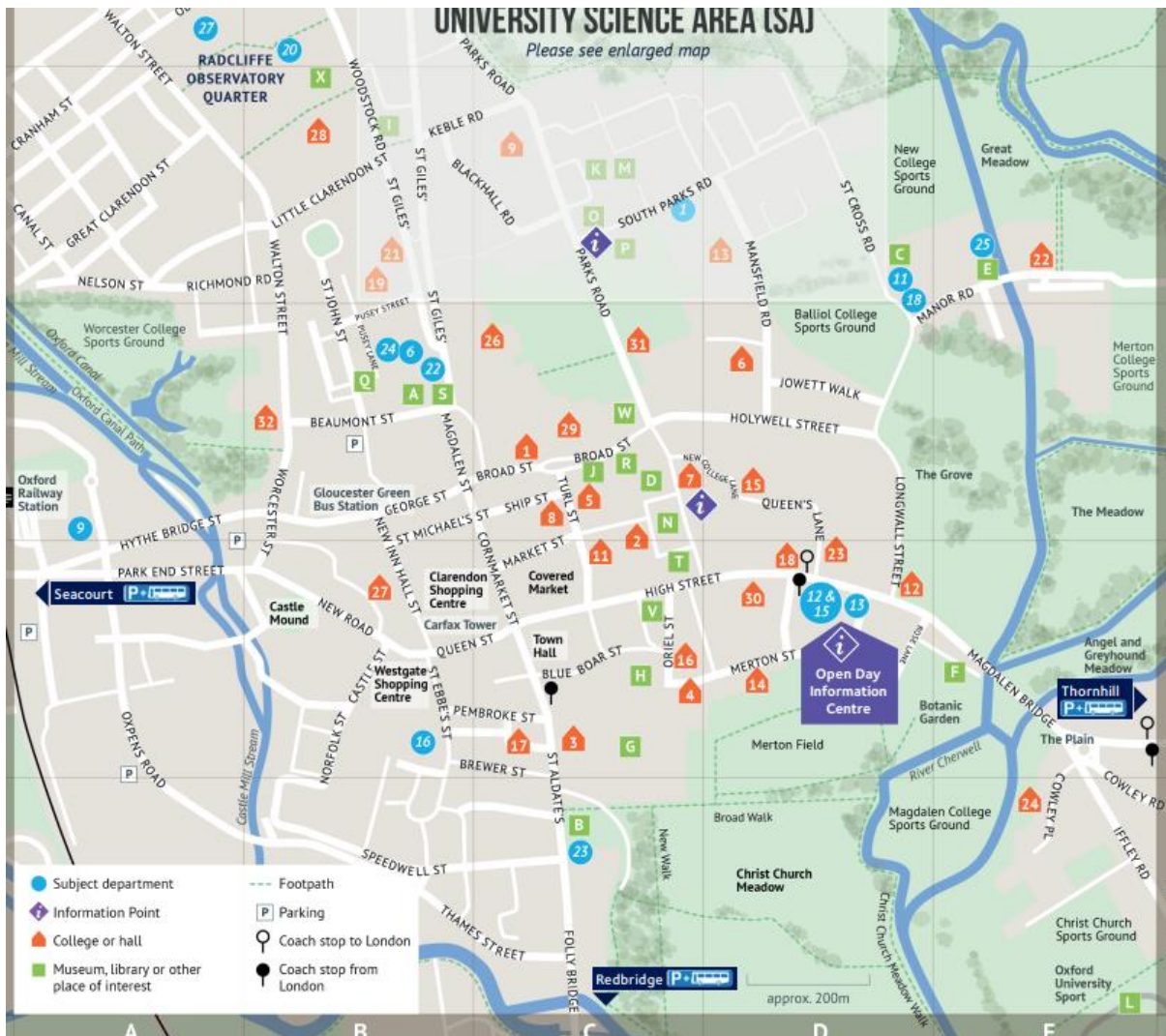
Information for attendees at ISRP Conference, Pembroke College, Oxford, September 2024

One of the benefits of Pembroke is its seclusion in the heart of the city. This also makes it hard to find. Here is a map – Pembroke College is Number 17 on the map (bottom centre). It is opposite Christ Church College (number 3).



The road to Pembroke (Pembroke Place) looks like it doesn't go anywhere but there is a door at the end on the left (see next photo). Just inside is the Porters' Lodge – which is where you check in. There is space to be dropped off but there is no parking unless pre-arranged for disabled access. Even then it is limited.

If you need to park the nearest public car-park is at the Westgate shopping Centre through the park and rides give better value. **DO NOT USE SEACOURT PARK AND**

RIDE OR TRY TO APPROACH FROM THE WEST – the bridge under the railway by the station is still closed to vehicles – access to the city is on foot only from there.
